

Grand Junction Colo
Sept 27 1900

Adjourned meeting of the City Council Mayor
Crahn in the chair. Upon Roll call the following
Aldermen responded Barton Broemser Covey
Dickerson Lee Shope and Smith.

Minutes of September 21 read and approved.

A petition from the school board of District No 1 was read asking for new side walk in front of the new school houses in Blocks 73 and 127 of the City of Grand Junction.

The following resolution was then introduced by Alderman Broemser who moved its adoption which was seconded by Ald Barton.

Whereas in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new side walk be constructed on the north side of Grand Avenue in front of lots 21 to 27 inclusive in Block 73. Also on the South side of Colorado Ave along and in front of lots 1 to 11 inclusive Block 127 of the City of Grand Junction.

Therefore be it ordered that a new side walk such as provided by ordinance save that it be six feet wide instead of 12 be constructed along and in front of said described lots under the provisions of the statutes and ordinances concerning side walk in such cases made and provided.

A vote was taken upon the foregoing resolution which resulted as follows Barton voted yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea

Moved and seconded That the communication of Chas W Haskell on sewer system wages be referred to the sewer committee Carried

Moved and seconded All new bills be referred to the Finance Committee Carried

Moved and seconded That Geo Stummety be allowed to address the Council Carried

~~Moved and seconded That The Giddes and Lewis Stone Co be allow \$1400 of the maintenance fund of the water works and 2 1/4 % of the water works construction fund~~

Upon motion of Alderman Smith which was seconded by Alderman Barton It was ordered that a warrant for \$2,142.23 upon the Water Works fund and a warrant for \$1400.00 upon the water fund be issued and delivered to the Giddes and Lewis Stone Co, on account of and in part payment of the amount due to fore and on the 21 day of September found and ascertained to be due to it, as per settlement, for balance due on account of construction of the City Water Works system for this City, leaving a balance due and yet to be paid as per said settlement of \$4082.29; by the following vote Alderman Barton voted yea Broemser yea Covey yea Dickerson yea The yea Shores yea Smith yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the Street Commissioner be instructed to cut and burn all Russian Thistle found within the City limits. Carried

Moved and seconded We adjourn to Thursday evening Sept 27 1900
