Adjourned meeting of the City Council
Mayor Elam in the Chair Upon Roll Call the
following Aldermen responded Barton Proemser
Lovey Dickerson Lee Shores and Smith, absent
Wharton Minutes of September 27 and October
1 read and approved

The following resolution was then
introduced by Alderman Lovey who moved
its adoption which was seconded by Alder-
man Smith. Be it resolved by the City
Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado
that for the purpose of defraying the expenses
and liabilities of said City of Grand Junction
for the fiscal year beginning April 1 A.D.
1901 and ending A.D. 1902 there be and is
hereby levied and assessed upon all the tax-
able property within the limits of said City
both real and personal the following special
and general amounts of taxes namely.

For the purpose of paying interest upon Water
Works Bonds seven and the half mills (.007 1/2)

For the purpose of running, operating and
maintaining the City Water Works seven mills (.007)
and for all other purposes eighteen mills (.018)
upon each dollar of taxable property as the
same is assessed and.

Be it further resolved that the City Clerk
be and is hereby instructed to certify this
levy to the County Clerk of Mesa County Colo.
as required by law.

A vote was taken upon the foregoing
resolution which was as follows Ald. Barton
voted yea, Proemser yea, Lovey yea, Dickerson yea
Lee yea, Shores yea and Smith yea carried

Moved and seconded that Mr. A. R. Wood
worth be allowed to address the City Council
upon the public library carried

Moved and seconded that the Clerk
ask the different plumbers to bid on tapping of
water mains from Oct 9 1900 to April 15 1901
and to receive pay for same in City Warrants
carried
