

Grand Junction Colo  
November 19 1900

Adjourned meeting of the City Council President of the Council Wharton in the Chair upon roll call the following Alderman responded Barton Broemser Covey Dickerson Lee, & Wharton Absent Show, Smith and Mayor E.A.

Minutes of November 13 read and approved Regular order of business suspended by unanimous consent.

Alderman Barton read the following resolution and moved its adoption, which was seconded by Alderman Dickerson

Be it Resolved that the Superintendent of Sewers be and he is hereby instructed to issue to Wm McGinley a permit to connect his premises in Lot 13, Block 6 of Richard D. Mobley's Sub-Division, with the line of sewer on first street, provided that such connection be made at the man hole nearest to said premises, and provided said McGinley shall pay to the City Treasurer a sum equal to .062826 per square foot of his said premises so to be connected to said sewer.

A vote was then taken on the foregoing resolution which resulted as follows Alderman Barton voted yea, Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the purchasing Committee investigate the cost of having two hundred pamphlets printed showing the location of the 'Y' connections with the sewer system and have the same printed if it does not exceed Ten dollars. A vote was taken on the foregoing resolution which was as follows Barton voted yea, Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That Superintendent Lemow of the Indian School be allowed to address the Council Carried

Moved by Alderman Barton and seconded by Alderman Dickerson That the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign a contract with the United States Government to furnish water to Teller Institute for ten years under the approval from year to year of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs at .15¢ per 1000 gallons and that the Superintendent

of the Water Works shall receive all water rentals  
A vote was then taken upon the foregoing  
motion which resulted as follows Alderman  
Barton voted yea, Broemser yea, Levy yea Dick-  
erson yea, Lee yea, Wharton yea, Carried.

Moved and seconded That Emanuel  
Brink be allowed to address the Council upon  
the extension of water mains on Curay and  
Eleventh Street Carried

Moved and seconded That all new  
bills be referred to the finance Committee Carried

Moved and seconded That the  
bill of S Remker for \$3<sup>00</sup> for hauling coal  
be allowed and warrant drawn for same  
A vote was then taken which resulted as  
follows Barton voted yea Broemser yea Levy  
yea Dickerson yea Lee yea, Wharton yea.  
Carried.
