Regular meeting of the City Council, Mayor
Ela in the chair. Upon Roll Call the following
Aldermen responded Barton, Levey, Dickerson
Lee, Shore, Smith and Wharton Absent Proemser.

Minutes of Nov 19. read and approved with
corrections

Moved and Seconded that ^{F. M.} M. L. Miller be
allowed to address the Council. Carried

Moved and Seconded That the matter of
a new bridge over the ^{big} ditch on 12th street and
the grading up of the road in that locality be
referred to the Street and Alley Committee. Carried

Moved and Seconded That J. E. Glassford
be allowed to address the Council on the matter of
contracting with the Continental Oil Co to furnish
the city with oil for the coming year. Carried

Moved and seconded that the matter of entering into a contract with the Continental Oil Co to furnish the City with oil for the ensuing year be referred to the Water Committee with power to act. A vote was taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton Voted yea Covey yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Wharton yea Carried

The monthly reports of the Marshal Treasurer, Waugher, Physician and Police Magistrate were referred to the Finance Committee upon motion.

Moved and seconded That The Water Committee be empowered to build new bulk-head for intake at pumping plant and purchase such material as is necessary. A vote was taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton voted yea, Covey, yea Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Shores yea, Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the communication from Luckett and Bergman asking permission to tap the raw system of Water Works on Orchard mesa be referred to the City Attorney. Carried

Moved and seconded That Walter Wilhelmy be given a rebate of \$²⁵ over charge of water rental. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea, Covey, yea Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Shores yea, Wharton yea Carried

Upon motion all new bills were referred to the Finance Committee

Moved and seconded That the Petition of J Bowers and others asking for an exclusive ditch into Nobles and Grand River Sub Divisions be referred to the Street and Alley Committee Carried

Moved and seconded That the services of O S Ramsay as a merchant Police be dispensed with and pay stoped. A vote was then taken which resulted as follows Barton voted nay Covey yea, Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Shores yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved and seconded That the City Clerk be and hereby is authorized to purchase such books as necessary to ^{keep} a record of the sewer assessments in the different districts. A vote was then taken on the foregoing motion yea Dickerson yea Lee yea Shores yea Wharton yea. Carried
