

Grand Junction Colo
Dec. 17, 1900

Adjourned meeting of the City Council
Mayor Elia in the Chair. Upon Roll call the
following Aldermen responded Barton, Broemser,
Covey, Dickerson, Lee, Shoes, Smith and Wharton
Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved with corrections

Moved and seconded That we reconsider
the vote of Dec 11 1900 on O.S. Ramsey as Mer-
chant Police and that he be reinstated at
the former salary of \$10 per month A vote
was then taken on the foregoing motion
which was as follows Barton voted yea,
Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson nay, Lee
nay, Shoes nay, Smith yea Wharton nay.
The result being a Tie Mayor Elia's name
was called he voting yea. Carried

Moved and seconded That the bond
of P.A. Whistler as a plumber be referred back
to him for correction Carried

The City Attorney reported back the
communication of Bucket and Bergman asking
permission to tap water mains on Orchard mesa.
with the recommendation that it be referred
to the Water committee to investigate and
fix price for water.

Moved and seconded that the
communication from Bucket and Bergman be
referred to the Water committee Carried

Moved and seconded That the City
Attorney and Clerk investigate the amount
due the saloon men on debate while closed
and report same at next meeting Carried

All new bills were referred to the
Finance Committee upon motion.

The following bills or ordinances were then introduced and laid on the table

"A Bill for an ordinance assessing the cost of the District Sanitary Sewer, with the appurtenances in and for Sewer District No One of the City of Grand Junction Colorado.

A Bill for an Ordinance assessing the cost of the District Sanitary Sewer, with the appurtenances, in and for Sewer District No Two, of the City of Grand Junction Colorado.

Moved and seconded That a new incandescent light be placed at the corner of 5th Street and Belfour Ave. A vote was taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton voted yea, Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson yea, Lee yea, Shous yea, Smith yea, Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That Mr. Cooper be allowed to address the Council upon the ^{matter} of the sale of the Electric Light plant to the City. Carried

Moved and seconded That the City Engineer have suitable blanks printed so as to notify people to number their houses. A vote was taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton voted yea Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson yea Lee yea Shous yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the matter of water for the Court house be referred to the water Committee Carried

Moved and seconded That it is the sense of this Council to issue to the Electric Light Company such bonds, ^{against the plant} as will be satisfactory to them at 4 1/2 % interest per annum, for such price as may be hereafter agreed upon, ^{for the purchase price} for its plant. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton vote yea Broemser yea, Covey yea, Dickerson yea Lee yea Shous yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded We adjourn until Monday at 2 P.M. Dec. 24 1900 Carried
