Magistrate, Treasurer, Janitor and Water Works were
upon motion referred to the Finance Committee.

The City Attorney was instructed to confer
with the County Attorney upon the matter of
building a Post house and report at next meeting
of the Council

Moved and seconded That the City Treasurer
be and here by is instructed to place such funds
as are available from fines into the proper fund
for the use of the Public Library Carried

Moved and seconded That the resignation
of H. J. German as Pumpman to take effect February 13 1901
be accepted and placed on file. Carried

Moved and seconded We employ Wm
Veder as pumpman to take charge of pumping plant
Feb 12 1901 at a salary of \$800.00 per month a
vote was taken which was as follows Barton voted yea

Wharton yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the Bond of Gracy and Merrick as Plumbers be approved and license granted Carried.

All new bills were refered to the Finance Committee upon motion

Moved and seconded That a warrant be draw for the Sewer fund for \$37.00 in favor of A. M. C. Nicklin for dust Pans for sewer system man holes. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea Lovey yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried

Moved and seconded That the Clerk make Mr Benton Canon the following offer for the Street Car Rail Way. The City of Grand Junction will give you \$750.00 for the Street Car Rail Way as it stands, clear of incumbrance and any title or claim you may have for franchise. Carried
The following resolution was then introduce

Whereas in the opinion of a two third majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed on the north side of Main street from Spruce Street to the Grand River Inclusive and along and in front of the east side of lot 1 Block 5, Richard D. Mobley's first subdivision to the town of Grand Junction.

Therefore be it ordered that a new sidewalk be constructed such as provided by ordinance save that it be six feet ^{wide} instead of 12 along and in front of said described property and lots under the provisions of the Statues and Ordinances concerning sidewalk in such cases made and provided.

Moved and seconded That the Clerk hire such help as will be necessary to complete the Assessment Roll of the Sewer System. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea Lovey yea Lee yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea. Carried
