response to the above call

Moved by Barton and seconded by
Wharton That we purchase the Grand Junction
Street Car Rail Way for \$875.00 payment to be made
on such terms as may be satisfactory to Mr.
Canon and that he shall furnish a clear title
in every respect, and the Mayor and Clerk are
further instructed to sign up such contract
upon the approval of the City Attorney

A vote was taken on the foregoing motion
which was as follows Barton voted yea, Levey yea
Lee nay, Shores yea, Wharton yea. Carried

Moved and seconded That the petition to
remove ditch and construct new side walk on
West Main Street be referred to the Street and
Alley committee with power to act. Carried

Moved and seconded That the extension
of water mains to the Residence of E. S. Pearson on
Third and Gunnison Streets be referred to the Water
Committee. Carried

Moved and seconded That the Superintendent
of Sewers be instructed to examine all sewers at ^{necessary} least once a week and have same flushed out. Carried
