

Grand Junction Colo.  
Feb 12 1901

Regular meeting of the City Council Mayor  
Ela in the chair Upon Roll Call the following  
Aldermen responded, Barton, Broemser, Covey, Hickerson,  
Shores, Smith and Wharton. Absent Lee.

All minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved.

The monthly reports of the Treasurer, Police Magis-  
trate, and Janitor were referred to the Finance Com-  
mittee.

The matter of leasing the Street Car was  
deferred until the transfer of the same was made  
to the City.

A Communication was received from  
the Secretary of the School Board asking that the  
Curfew ordinance be enforced more strictly. The  
matter was referred to Ald. Barton to report to the  
Police officers and have same enforced.

The following resolution was then introduced  
(Whereas) in the opinion of a two thirds  
majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new side  
walk be constructed on the East side of 5th street along  
and in front of lots 1 and 32 in Block 16, and lots 1 and  
32 in Block 29. in the City of Grand Junction Colo.

Therefore be it ordered that a new side  
walk be constructed such as provided by Ordinance  
save that it be six feet wide instead of 12, along and  
in front of said described property and lots under  
the provisions of the Statute and Ordinance concerning  
side walk in such cases made and provided.

A vote was then taken on the foregoing  
resolution which was as follows: Barton voted yea,  
Broemser yea, Hickerson yea, Shores yea, Smith yea,  
Wharton yea. Carried.

All new bills were upon motion referred  
to the Finance Committee.

Upon motion J. G. Broemser was given a  
permit to lay 125 feet of 2 inch <sup>water</sup> pipe on 5th street and 400  
feet in the Alley between North and Belfour Avenue for  
domestic purposes.

Moved and seconded That the Marshal  
instruct St. Mary's Hospital to fill up cess <sup>the</sup> pool in the  
rear of their building as the same was becoming  
dangerous. Carried.

Moved and seconded That the  
Mayor appoint a committee of three to investigate the  
value of the present Electric light plant and the cost  
of the construction of a new plant and also secure  
all the other data they could. Carried.

The Mayor appointed Aldermen Barton, Smith and Covey.

Moved and Seconded That the City of Grand Junction furnish water to the County for the Court House and Jail free of charge until the further order of the Council. The County to pay all expence incurred by tapping. Carried

Moved and Seconded That a committee be appointed to investigate the securing of land and the cost of a pest-house and report on Feb 20. Carried

The Mayor appointed the following Aldermen on the above committee Covey, Smith and Shores.

Moved and Seconded That the purchasing Committee confer with the Clerk regarding the building of a case for papers and City records and have same built A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea Covey yea, Dickerson yea Shores yea Smith yea Wharton yea Carried

Moved and Seconded That the front Room of the City Hall be designated as the Police Court Room. Carried

Moved and Seconded That J. O. Glasgow be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of Oil for the pumping the coming year Carried

Moved and Seconded That the Mayor and Clerk sign a contract with the Continental Oil Co to furnish the City with oil for the pumping plant the coming year Carried
