

Grand Junction Colorado  
Feb. 20. 1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council  
Mayor Eld in the chair. Upon Roll Call the follow-  
ing Aldermen responded Barton, Lovey, Dickerson  
Lee Shores Smith and Wharton. Absent Broemser.  
Minutes of previous meeting read and  
approved

The following resolution was then intro-  
duced

Whereas in the opinion of a two thirds  
Majority of the City Council it is necessary that a  
side walk be constructed on the south side of Curay  
Street between 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Streets along and in front of  
lots 14, 15 and sixteen in Block 71 in the City of Grand  
Junction Colo.

Therefore be it ordered that a new  
side walk be constructed such as provided by Ordin-  
ance save that it be six feet wide instead of  
twelve along and in front of said described property  
or lots under the provision of the Statute and Ordin-  
ance concerning side walk in such cases made  
and provided. A vote was then taken on the  
foregoing motion which was as follows - Barton voted  
yea, Lovey, yea, Dickerson, yea, Lee yea, Shores, yea, Smith,  
yea, Wharton, yea, Carried

Moved and Seconded that the Communi-  
cation from Mrs. Susie Carpenter ~~asking~~ permission  
to connect her residences on the corner of Main and  
First Streets be referred to the Sewer Committee with  
power to act. Carried

Moved & Seconded that the Committee  
appointed to investigate the cost of a feet house and  
the selection of a ~~site~~ for the same be given power  
to proceed in the construction of the same with the  
County Commissioners. A vote was taken which was as  
follows Barton voted yea, Lovey, yea, Dickerson, yea,  
Lee yea, Shores yea, Smith yea, Wharton, yea, Carried

Moved and seconded That the Mayor appoint a committee of three to correspond with the Geddis and Lewis Stone Co. in regard to the reconstruction of the reservoir of the City Water Work. Carried

The Mayor appointed Aldermen Wharton and Lee and City Attorney Staley on the Committee

Moved and seconded That the Street Commissioner have all the sewer pipes picked up and put in the Celler of the City Hall also any water pipe that may be left anywhere around town, and that no more of either be sold or given away Carried

Moved and seconded That G. A. Currie be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of water being piped past his building on the corner of 5th and Colorado Avenue Carried

Moved and seconded That the Marshall serve notice on the owners of the lots on the corner of fifth and main street to have the hole filled up on those lots as the same was a nuisance. Carried

Moved and seconded That the matter of running ditch water in front of certain property be referred to the Street and Alley Committee and the City Attorney Carried

~~Moved and seconded That we adjourn until Wednesday evening Feb. 27 1901~~

Ordinance No 101 was then introduced by Alderman Dickerson who moved its adoption

Ordinance No 101 Being "an Ordinance to Amend Section 3 of A Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning Water Works and to repeal certain other Ordinances" Passed and adopted February 19th A.D. 1900.
