March 12 - 1901

A Regular meeting of the City Council, Mayor Elia in the chair. Upon Roll call the following Aldermen responded. Barton, Broenser, Lovey, Lee, Shores, Smith, and Wharton. Absent Dickerson

Minutes of the previous meeting read and approved.

Upon motion the monthly reports of the City Treasurer, Police Magistrate and City Weigher were referred to the finance committee.

Moved and seconded That the bid of J.A.K Crawford for One hundred thousand hard burnt brick or as many more as may be necessary to complete the reservoir, delivered, at \$8.40 per m. be accepted. A vote was then taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows: Barton voted yea, Broenser yea, Lovey yea, Lee yea, Shores yea, Smith yea, Wharton yea, Carried

Moved and seconded We take a five minute recess to allow the finance committee to make its report. Carried

Moved and seconded That the rules be suspended and we adopt the Annual Appropriation ordinance no. 102. Carried

Moved and seconded That Ordinance No 102 being the 'Annual Appropriation Ordinance' be accepted as read. A vote was then taken which was as follows: Barton voted yea, Broenser yea, Lovey yea, Lee yea, Shores yea, Smith yea, Wharton yea. Carried
