Moved and seconded That the Street and Alley Committee purchase a suitable horse for use in the fire team and that they Mayor sell the old horse at auction to the highest bidder A vote was then taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton voted yea, Bronner yea Covey yea Dickerson nay, Lee yea Shore yea Smith yea Wharton yea. tract! said warrant to be delivered to said County of Mesa by Alderman Shores upon the delivery to him for the City of a good and sufficient Warranty Deed to be approved by the City attorney conveying to the City an undivided one-half interest in said five acre tract upon which said hospital has been erected.
