May 6, 1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council. Mayor
Sampliner in the chair. Upon roll call, the following
Aldermen Responded Barton, Hards, Hutchinson, Lee
and Mantey. Absent Dickerson, Shores, and Waldroup.

Minutes of April 29, 1901, read and Approved
Moved and Seconded We dispense with the regular
order of business and take up the Reservoir matter
Carried

Moved and Seconded That all members of
the water committee write to any and all persons
who have had any experience in the construction
of Reservoirs, and secure such information as
possible. Carried

The communication of W.C. Meserve upon
the reservoir was upon motion referred to the
Water Committee

Moved and Seconded That the City Attorney
purchase one acre of ground for a right of way for
water mains through Orchard Mesa Cemetery from
A. L. Gourley at \$40 per acre. A vote was then taken
which was as follows Barton voted yea Hards yea
Hutchinson yea, Lee yea Mantey yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the Street Commissioner be allowed to address the Council on the construction of side walk on West Main Street

The matter of the construction of side walks on West Main Street was upon motion referred to the Street and Alley Committee

Moved and seconded that A. L. Gourley be furnished water for the Cemetery at 18¢ per 1000 gallons ^{meter measurement} a vote was then taken which was as follows: Barton voted yea, Hards yea, Hutchinson yea, Lee yea, Mantey yea, Carrus.

Moved and seconded We adjourn until next regular Meeting Tuesday Evening May 14 at 8 PM 1901 Carried
