July 30 - 1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council Mayor
Sampliner in the Chair. Upon Roll Call the follow-

Moved and seconded We dispense with the
regular order of Business and allow any citizen
present address the Council. Carried

J. F. Moore appeared before the Council and
asked to have an electric light placed at the
Rail Road crossing on South 7th Street for the
convenience of the Fruit growers who are compelled
to cross the track in the night

The Matter of a light at the Rail Road
crossing on South 7th Street was upon motion duly
seconded referred to the Water & Light Committee

Mr Eldridge Chairman of the Peach Day
Committee appeared before the Council and asked the
Council for \$800.00 for a Peach Day Celebration

The matter was of \$800 dollars for Peach
Day was laid over until Aug 2 1901

Moved and seconded That when we
adjourn, we adjourn until Aug 2 1901 and
that we take up the matter of a Peach Day
donation at that time Carried

Moved and seconded That we appoint A. J.
Ramsey as a Merchant Police without pay ^{from the City} to file
a bond as required by law. A vote was then taken

Moved and seconded That the Water
Committee have power to act in the matter of having

Moved and Seconded That Ordinance No 105 be adopted as read Ordinance No 105 being "A Bill for Ordinance No 105. An Ordinance to Authorize the Grand Valley Gas and Oil Company (A Corporation) to operate gas and oil pipe lines within the corporate limits of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado and to sell and deliver gas, oil and kindred substances for illuminating, heating, power and general commercial uses to consumers thereof in said City and for such purposes to own and control wells and refineries, and to own, lay and repair pipe lines in and through the streets and alleys thereof. A vote was then taken on the adoption of the foregoing Ordinance which was as follows Barton voted yea Dickerson yea Harbo yea Hutchinson nay Lee yea Mantley yea Shores not present when the vote was taken Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and Seconded That the clerk have the proposed Ordinance No 106 published, Ordinance No 106 being "An Ordinance concerning licenses" A vote was then taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows Barton voted yea Dickerson yea Harbo yea Hutchinson yea Lee yea Mantley yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and Seconded That J. D. Roberts be heard on the condition of the side walk on south 7th Street Carried

The matter of a new side walk on South Seventh Street was upon motion referred to the Street & Alley Committee

Moved and Seconded That Frank Thompson be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of Interstate merchants.

The matter of Internate merchants was upon motion refered to the License Committee

Moved and seconded That Chas Jenkins be allowed to address the Council upon the cutting down of the Electric light Co's Bill Carried

Moved and seconded That the Clerk advertise for bids for the hauling of coal to the pump house for the balance of the ^{procal} year. Carried

Moved and seconded We adjourn until Friday Night Aug 2 at 8. P.M. 1901 Carried
