August 23-1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council, Mayor Sampson in the chair. Upon Roll call the following Aldermen responded, Dickerson, Harde, Hutchinson, Shores and Waldroup. Absent Barton, Lee and Mantey.

Moved and Seconded We dispense with the reading of the Minutes Carried

The Water and Light Committee recommended two thirty two candle power Incandescent lamps one for the crossing near west 14th street and the others at Hines residence in Crawford's addition.

Moved and Seconded That the bill of J. W. Sampson for \$27⁵⁰ money advanced for expert-repairer men be allowed and warrant drawn for the same. A vote was then taken which was as follows Dickerson voted yea Harde yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and Seconded That the Street Commission secure new lumber for the water flume in Crawford's addition. A vote was then taken which was as follows Dickerson voted yea Harde yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea. Carried

in the alley between Islands and Bunting be
referred to the Street & Alley Committee. Resolved
