Regular meeting of the City Council Mayor
Sampliner in the Chair Upon Bill Call the
following Aldermen responded, Dickerson, Hards
Hutchinson Shores and Waldroup. Absent
Barton, Lee and Mantley.

Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved

The application and bond of Walter Wilhelmy
for a Beer license was upon motion referred to the License
Committee.

Moved and seconded That the Supt of Sewers
issue a sewer permit to W T. Howrey to connect his
premises on Colo Ave. with the sewer system at the
Man-hole on First street upon the payment \$0.0042600
per sq. foot of Area Carried

The monthly report of the Police Magistrate
City Weights and Treasures was upon motion referred
to the Finance Committee.

The Supt of W. W. report was upon
motion referred to the Water Committee.

The communication from the City
Engineer regarding the resurveying of the City
was upon motion referred to the Street & Alley Committee.

The matter sign boards for the streets
was upon motion referred to the street and alley
Committee with power to act by the following
vote, Dickerson voted yea Hards yea Hutchinson
yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Upon motion duly seconded, The Contract
between Bergman & Duckett for lumber for a wing
into the river at the pump house, made by the
water committee was duly ratified by the
following vote Dickerson voted yea Hards yea
Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and seconded that the Proposition
W. C. Mearns, to put a new front in the City Hall
for \$100⁰⁰ be accepted, he to furnish a \$500⁰⁰
bond the Mayor and City Clerk to sign contract
in behalf of the City. A vote was then taken
which was as follows Dickerson voted yea Hards
yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea
Carried.

Moved and seconded That Geo Smith be
Allowed to address the Council upon the matter
of furnishing the City with Electric power to
run its pumps at the water works and light
the City. Carried

The matter of Electric Power for
light and power purposes was upon motion re-

ferred to the Water and Light Committee to confer with Mr. Smith

Moved and seconded That the County Treasurer be notified to abate the collection of sewer tax against any ^{public Parks} and all city property by the following vote. Dickerson voted yea Hards yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and seconded That we vacate the street Car barn and cease to use the same. The car to be placed in the City Corral.

A vote was then taken which was as follows Dickerson voted yea Hards yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the Supt of Water Works place one of the fountains that is not in use in the Park. A vote was then taken on the foregoing motion which was as follows. Dickerson voted yea Hards yea Hutchinson yea Shores yea Waldroup yea Carried

The Mayor then appointed Dickerson, Hutchinson and Waldroup as a committee of investigation

The matter of hiring a City Plumber to inspect sewer work, and other plumbing was upon motion referred to the Water and Sewer Committee
