Oct 22 1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council
Mayor Sanghmer in the Chair Upon Roll Call the
following Aldermen responded. Barton, Dickerson,
Hards, Hutchinson, Lee and Shore. Absent Mantey
and Waldroup.

Minutes of previous meeting read and
approved

The petition of D. S. Dickie and others asking
the City Council not to grant any more saloon licenses
to people wishing to conduct saloons in Block 118 was
received and upon motion duly seconded was
placed on file

Moved and seconded That the Superintendent
of the Water Works lay 1200 feet of pipe into Carpenters
addition. Residents living in that locality to pay
water rent two years in advance. The cost of laying
the pipe line completed not to exceed \$450.00. A vote
was then taken which was as follows. Barton
voted yea Dickerson yea Hards yea Hutchinson yea
Lee yea Shore yea Carried

Moved and seconded That the Street
and Alley Committee be given more time in which
to report on Street Crossings. Carried

The Committee on the Electric light proposition
made a written report which was upon motion
received and placed on file

Moved and seconded That P. E. Fuller
of Denver be allowed to address the Council
upon the matter of building an electric
light plant. Carried

Moved and seconded That Geo. Sten-
mety be allowed to address the Council upon
the matter of a settlement of the sewers. Carried

Moved and seconded That the
Mayor appoint a committee of four including
himself to investigate and make an estimate
of the cost of settling the power system and
report to the Council. Carried

The Mayor appointed on the above
Committee Alderman Barton, Hards, and Hutchinson

Moved and seconded That a warrant
be drawn in favor of the Geddis & Series Stone
Co on the water fund for \$482.09 in final
settlement of the water system. A vote was then
taken which was as follows. Barton voted yea
Dickerson yea Hards yea Hutchinson Nay Shore
yea. Carried

to the finance Committee.
