Nov. 6 1901

Adjourned meeting of the City Council. Mayor
Samplers in the Chair Whom Roll call the follow-
ing Alderman Responded Dickerson Hards Hutchinson
Lee Manty Shores and Waldroup Absent Alderman
Barton

Moved and Seconded We dispense with
the regular order of business and take up any
Special business which may come before the
Council. Carried

Moved and Seconded That Mrs A.R.
Wadsworth be allowed to address the Council
upon the matter of finances for the Public
Library. Carried

Moved and Seconded that the
matter of Revenue for the Public Library be
referred to the Finance Committee to report
at next regular meeting. Carried

Alderman Lee then introduces the
following resolution and moved its adoption
which was seconded by Alderman Hards.

Be it resolved by the City Council of
the City of Grand Junction Colo. that for the pur-
pose of defraying the expense and liabilities
of the City of Grand Junction for the fiscal
year beginning April 1st 1902 and ending
March 31st 1903 there shall be and here by is
levied and assessed upon all the taxable property
within the corporate limits of said city both of
real and personal the following amount of
special and general taxes etc.

For the purpose of paying annual
interest on City Water Works Bonds a special
tax of 4 Mills

For the purpose of running repairing
and operating the City Water Works System a
special tax of 14 Mills

and for all other purposes 10 Mills
on each dollar of the valuation of all taxable
property in said city as the same is assessed;
and the City Clerk is hereby instructed to certify
this levy to the County Clerk of Mesa County
Colorado as required by law.

A vote was then taken upon the
adoption of the foregoing resolution which
was as follows Dickerson voted yea Hards
yea Hutchinson yea Lee yea Shores yea
Manty yea Waldroup yea. Carried
