The Petition of Bramard and others
 asking for a side walk and crossing on Seventh
 and Alcheta was read and upon motion duly
 seconded referred to the Street & Alley Committee.

The Petition of the Grand Junction Lignum
 Co and other asking for an electric light
 at the corner of 4th Street & Co's Ave was read
 and upon motion duly seconded referred to
 the Water and Light Committee.

The Finance Committee reported favorable
 upon the Treasurers report for the months of June
 July Aug. September.

Moved and seconded That the reports
 be accepted and placed on File. Carried.

The Water Committee reported favorable
 upon the reports of the Supt of Water Works.

Moved and seconded That the
 report be accepted and placed on File. Carried.

Moved and seconded That the matter
 of pipe to carry water into Carpenters addition
 be referred to the Water Committee with power
 to act. A vote was then taken which was as
 follows Barton voted yea Dickerson yea Harde
 yea Hutchinson yea Lee yea Mantey yea
 Shows yea. Carried.

Moved and seconded That the report
 on Street Crossings be accepted and two new crossings
 be put in. The location of the place to be left
 to the Street and Alley Committee. A vote was then
 taken which was as follows Barton voted yea
 Dickerson yea Harde yea Hutchinson yea Lee yea
 Shows yea Mantey yea. Carried.

Moved and seconded That the Police
 Department keep all men and boys moving along
 the street and stop the congregating of crowds
 in front of the Pastors and Colorado State Band
 steps. Carried.

Moved and seconded That a committee
 of three be appointed to investigate into the
 safety of the Sun Building & Scovills storage
 rooms. Carried.

The matter of Painting the City Hall was upon motion laid on the table
