Sampliner in the Chair. Upon Roll Call

Moved and seconded we dispense
with the regular order of business and take
up the tax levy. Carried

The following resolution was
then introduced

Resolved that the resolution
levying taxes for the current year adopted
November 6 1901 be and the same is
hereby modified and amended so as to
read as follows.

"Be it resolved by the City Council
of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that
for the purpose of defraying the expense
and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction
for the fiscal year beginning April 1 1902
and ending March 31 1903, there shall
be and hereby is levied and assessed upon
all the taxable property within the corporate
limits of said City both real and personal
the following amounts of special and general
taxes viz

For the purpose of paying annual
interest on Water Works Bonds a special tax of
.04 (four) mill

For the purpose of running repair-
ing and operating the City Water Works system
a special tax of .04 (four) mill

And for all other purposes 8 1/2 mill
on each dollar of the valuation of all taxable
property in said City as the same is
assessed and the City Clerk is hereby instructed
to certify this levy to the County Clerk of Mesa

County as required by law.

A vote was then taken upon the adoption of the foregoing resolution which was as follows
