Regular Meeting of the City Council Mayor

The Petition of Burk asking permission  
to connect with the sewer system was upon  
motion referred to the Water and Sewer Committee

The Application of Sam Gleason for a  
Saloon license to conduct a saloon in Block 144  
was on motion referred to the License Committee

The monthly report of the Police Magistrate  
City Weigher and Treasurer were upon motion referred  
to the Finance Committee.

The monthly report of the Supt of Water  
Works was upon motion referred to the Water Committee

The Light and Water Committee recommend  
ed one thirty two candle power incandescent lamp  
for the corner of 4th St & Colorado Avenue.

Moved and Seconded That the City  
Clerk be instructed to notify the Geddis & Shero  
Contractors that the City will settle and refill the  
sewer system for the sum of eight hundred and
