Adjourned meeting of the City Council
Mayor Spauliner in the Chair Upon Roll
Call the following Aldermen responded
Barton, Dickerson, Hards, Hutchinson, Lee, Mantey,
Shores and Waldroup.

The reading of the minutes of the previous
meeting were dispensed with.

Moved and Seconded That Mr Beard of
Chicago be allowed to address the council upon
the matter of purchasing fire hose. Carried

Moved and Seconded That the City enter
into a contract with the Eureka Fire hose Co. for
1000 feet of hose @ 70¢ per foot. One half to be paid
June 1-1902 the remainder to be paid April 1
1903 without interest. The Mayor and City to
have power to sign contract in behalf of the
City.

Moved and Seconded That Chief Rogers
of the fire department be allowed to address the
council upon the matter of a new Fire Wagon
and the purchase of hose Carried

Moved and Seconded That J. J. Lunsden

be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of settling and refilling the sewer system. Carried. The Water Committee then made the following written report.

We the undersigned Water Committee respectfully recommend to the Council that we employ Mr. Barton to take full charge of constructing the reservoir and employ such help as he may see fit, with the assistance of a competent Concrete Man.

The Committee recommends that the city construct its own reservoir of 132 x 132 x 10 feet.

Bottom concrete 16 inches thick.
Side Walls bottom 14 " top 8 inches.
All material to be the very best quality.

Bids for all material to be submitted to the public by advertising in one of our newspapers published in the City of Grand Junction.
