Mar. 11 1902

Regular meeting of the City Council
Mayor Sanpliner in the chair Upon Roll Call
the following Aldermen responded Barton, Dickerson,
Hards, Hutchinson, Lee, Mantey and Shores. Absent
Waldroup.

Minutes of unapproved meeting read
and approved.

Moved and seconded That Rev J. M. P.
Martin be allowed to address the Council upon the
matter of grounds for a Business College and Normal
school Carried

Moved and seconded That the City
Attorney prepare an ordinance vacating the
alley in Block 6 of the City of Grand Junction Carried

The matter of water for the proposed
Normal and Business College was upon referred to
the water and sewer Committee to investigate

Moved and seconded That building
permits be granted to the Union Amusement
Company and P. J. Suff. The erection of the
building to be under the supervision of the
Fire & Police Committee. A vote was then
taken which was as follows Barton voted yea
Dickerson yea Hards yea Hutchinson yea Lee yea
Mantey yea Shores yea Carried

Moved and seconded That work
must commence on the above two buildings
within ten days from this date. Carried

The petition for a new side walk
on Colorado Ave between third and fourth streets
and the removal of rubbish on the corner of
Colorado Ave and third street was received, read and
upon motion duly seconded referred to
the street & alley Committee

The City attorney reported that

The County Court had given T. M. Todd and others the privilege of both drawing from the City limits

The report of the attorney was accepted and placed on file

The monthly reports of the Police Magistrate, Letty Weigher and City Treasurer were read and upon motion duly seconded referred to the Finance Committee

The Supt. of water work report and recommendations were read and referred to the Water Committee.

Moved and seconded that the Supt. of water work be allowed to address the Council upon the matter of a water rate for gardens for 1902. Carried

A communication was received from Philip Swardfeger City teamster asking the Council to increase his pay to \$2.00 per day or \$50.00 per month.

The matter of raising the teamsters salary was upon motion placed on file

The Committee on the purchase of a fire wagon asked for more time in which to make its report.

Upon motion duly seconded the Committee on the purchase of a fire wagon was given more time.

The Water Committee recommended the the Petition of Rust Bros and others for an extension of water mains on South St. from 7th to 9th be not granted as the consumers are not sufficient.

Moved and seconded Report of the Committee be accepted Carried

The Water Committee Recommended the taking of of the 4 in water pipe on 8th betwixt 10th and 11th and laying the 8 in pipe on Colorado Ave to 9th street and then finish the distance to 10th street with 2 inch pipe

Moved and seconded That the report of the Water Committee be accepted and the work done under the supervision of the water Superintendent. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea, Dickerson yea, Harbo, yea, Hutchinsons yea Lee yea, Mantel yea Shore yea Carried

The Communication of J. J. Falls asking for a rebate of money expended on laying pipe was upon motion referred to the

Water Committee to investigate

Moved and Seconded That a balling alley license be granted Sommer + Barte for one year for the sum of \$35.00 and that the Mayo and Clark sign license. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted yea, Dickerson yea, Hards yea, Hutchinson yea Lee yea Mautey yea Shores yea Carried

The Street and Alley Committee recommended a side walk along the North side of Grand Avenue in front of Block 75. The report was accepted and the following resolution introduced

Where as in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new side walk be constructed along and in front of the South side of Block 75 and lots 17 to 32 Inclusive.

Therefore be it ordered that a new side walk be constructed such as provided by ordinance save that it be six feet wide instead of twelve along and in front of the above described property and lots, under the provisions of the Statute and Ordinance in such cases made provided. A vote was then taken on the foregoing resolution which was as follows!

Barton voted yea, Dickerson yea, Hards yea, Hutchinson yea Lee yea, Mautey yea Shores yea. Carried

The matter of repairing the side walk on Colorado Ave between third and fourth and on several other streets was referred to the street and Alley Committee.

Moved and seconded That all new bills be referred to the finance Committee. Carried. Proposed Ordinance No 108 was then introduced by Alderman Slickerson who moved its publication which was seconded by Alderman Hutchinson. Ordinance No 108 being the "Annual Appropriation Ordinance". The Clerk was then instructed to have the same published according to law.

Moved and seconded That the Wardens salary be raised to \$90⁰⁰ per month with no fee. A vote was then taken which was as follows Barton voted nay. Slickerson yea, Hards nay Hutchinson nay Lee nay. Manty nay Shore yea. Lost.

Moved and seconded. That the matter of Salary for City officials for the coming year be referred to the Finance Committee. The Mayor and City Attorney to report on at next meeting of the City Council. Carried.

Moved and seconded We adjourn until Mar 12 at 8 P.M. 1901. Carried.
