The Water Committee reported favorable
upon the following recommendations of the
Superintendent of Water Works

To the Honorable Mayor & City Council
Gentlemen

For the fiscal year
beginning April 1st 1902. I recommend a re estab-
lishment of last years water rates except that
that a two center ²⁴ inch yard be made for gardens
and Orchards under the same restrictions as
applied to lawns.

I further recommend that water meters
be placed free for all purposes to Consumers and
that an annual rental of 12 percent of the cost of
the meters be charged to cover wear and tear on
same. The number of meters to be placed each
month to be left to the discretion of the City Council

Also that a discount of 5% be made to all
consumers who will pay a years water rent in
advance before May 1st 1902.
