Resolution granting sewer permits and ordering the laying of sewer pipe & water main to Bk 135

Whereas School District No 1 of Mesa County Colorado has deposited with the Superintendent of Water Works and Sewers the sum of \$628.20 to be by him expended towards defraying the expenses of extending the City's water mains and sewers to the West line of Lot 1 in Block 134 of this City.

Now Therefore be it resolved that said Superintendent is hereby instructed to at once make such extensions of said water mains and sewer paying the expenses there of out of said money so deposited so far as the same shall suffice and that he issue to said school district permits to connect on Block 9+ and 13+ to the sewer system with out further charge.
