Adjourned meeting of the City Council
Mayor Sampson in the Chair Upon Roll Call
the following aldermen responded Brunner
Hards Hutchinson Mantey McCarry Shores and
Waldroup absent Burton

The following resolution was then
introduced

for 1902

12 mills

Be it resolved by the City Council of
the City of Grand Junction Colorado That for
the purpose of defraying the expenses and
liabilities of the City of Grand Junction for the
Fiscal year beginning April 1-1903 and
ending March 31-1904 there shall be and
hereby is levied and assessed upon all the
taxable property within the Corporate limits
of said City both real and personal the
following amounts of special and general
taxes viz.

For the purpose of paying annual
interest on water works bonds a special
tax of 4 (four) mills

For the purpose of running repairing
and operating a City water works system
a special tax of 4 mills and

For all other purposes Twelve (12) mills
on each dollar of the valuation of all the
taxable property in said City as the same
is assessed and

The City Clerk is hereby instructed
to certify this levy to the County Clerk of
Mesa County as required by law.

A vote was then taken on the
fore going resolution which was as follows
