The following resolution was then
introduced

New side
walk

Whereas in the opinion of a two thirds
majority of the City Council it is necessary that
a new side walk be constructed along and in front
of the following described property. Therefore
be it ordered that a new side walk be constructed
such such as provided by ordinance ^{in such cases made and provided} save that
it be 6 feet wide instead of 12. along and in front
of lots 1 & 32 Block 107. Lots 1 & 32 - Block 114. also lot
16 in Block 117. which must be of concrete or stone.

A vote was then taken which was
as follows. Harbo voted yea Hutchinson yea
Mantley yea Shores yea McGary yea Waldrough
yea. Carried.

Ordinance
No 116.

Ordinance No 116 was then introduced
by Alderman Harbo who moved its adoption.
Ordinance No 116 being the "Annual Appropriation
Ordinance" A vote was then taken upon
the passage and adoption of the above ordinance
which was as follows Harbo voted yea Hutchin-
son yea Mantley yea McGary yea Shores yea
Waldrough yea. Carried.

taken on the foregoing ordinance
