No one having appeared to make  
objections to the side walk assessment, it

of 9<sup>00</sup> a lot <sup>and 100 penalty</sup> each as a special side walk tax  
here to fore made against lot 7 Block 108 and  
lot 10 Block 127 be confirmed and the City Clerk  
is hereby instructed to certify this levy. to the  
County official having charge of the tax  
schedule. Carried

A vacancy being caused by the  
resignation of Geo R Barton as Pres. of the  
Council and alderman Nominations  
were made to fill the vacancy.

Fred Mantey being the only nominee  
a motion was then made. to close the  
nominations and instructing the clerk  
to cast the ballot of the Council for Fred  
Mantey as President. Carried

The Clerk thereupon cast the  
vote of the City Council for Fred Mantey as  
President of the Council.
