Indian School Sewer

The Contract with the US Government concerning the Indian School Sewer was taken up, and it was in substance as follows: To allow the Indian School right of way through the alleys and across streets in said city and with the right to construct a six inch main sewer and connect with the main sewer of the City of Grand Jet at the intersection of 2d Street and the alley south of South Street, for one year at a rental of \$100.00 per annum, with the privilege by the United State Government to renew the contract ^{from year to year} for 99 years -

On motion duly seconded and put, to Ratify the Contract and direct the Mayor to sign and the City Clerk to attest said contract, Carried as shown by the following vote -
