Bids

The Bid of J.J. Lunsden to crush rock provided the City would deliver the rock at the crusher and take it away - at 40 Cents per ton;

Motion made seconded and put to refer the above bid to the Water & Sewer Committee with power to act - Carried

Bid of Harry Conley to haul rock from river to crusher and from crusher to reservoir site at \$1.75 per cubic yard

On motion second and put to ~~refer the above~~ refer the above bid of Harry Conley to the Water & Sewer Committee with power to act provided they retain 25% of the contract price until job is complete and accepted by said Committee, a vote was taken as follows: + Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Stockton yea, Smith yea, Waldroup yea, Carried
