First in order was the reading of the above call for special meeting.

Sidewalk

The Street and alley committee reported on the School Board Sidewalk petition, whereupon Alderman Hards introduced the following resolution and word

its adoption,, Whereas, in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that new sidewalks be constructed on the West side of 9<sup>th</sup> Street from White Street to South Street, also on the East side of 9<sup>th</sup> Street from White Street to School Grounds, also from Eleventh Street on main street to join I N Buntings walk, <sup>at no 1037 main street</sup> also on both sides of Tenth Street from Road Street to Colorado Avenue also on South side of Colorado Avenue from Tenth to Eleventh Streets, Therefore be it resolved that new sidewalks be constructed along and in front of said Blocks and Streets and that the same ~~be constructed of concrete to be five or six feet wide, or if~~ be constructed of Plank to be Six (6) feet wide instead of 12 feet such as provided by ordinance in such case made and provided, <sup>or in lieu thereof a firm 6 foot concrete walk.</sup> being seconded and put the following vote was taken, Buckins voted yea, Harbo yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Carried —

The petition of Kersberg and Hertz for license to wholesale liquors on Lots 19 + 20 in Block 119 signed by owners of 10 lots in <sup>South side of</sup> said block also their bond in the sum of Two Thousand dollars in due form signed by <sup>Mayor</sup> Kersberg & Hertz as principal and Orson Adams Jr and A R Sampson as sureties, was presented and motion made seconded and put, to Grant said license and approve said bond, a vote was then taken as follows; Buckins voted yea, Harbo yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Carried —
