Minutes of Aug 11th, Aug 19th, Sept 1st and Sept 4th 1903 were read, corrected as to Lot number in sidewalk ordered laid instead of "M Bunting walk" also to insert in sidewalk resolution that a 6 foot sidewalk of plank be laid and in lieu thereof a 5 foot concrete walk could be laid - Minutes all meetings mentioned above were then approved:
