Adjourned regular meeting of the City Council Mayor Jampliner in the chair. The following Alderman responded to roll call: Buckins, Hards, Merrill, Prader, Ramey, Smith, Stockton, Alderman Waldroup was a few minutes tardy, Those absent were Atty Carnahan who was represented by Atty VanStoorbike and Clerk Leslie whose place was filled by Alderman Merrill.
