

Grand Junction Colo Oct 16 1903

Adjourned regular Meeting of the City Council Mayor
Sampson in the Chair. The following Aldermen

Motion made seconded and put to Grant licenses to sell liquors as prescribed in said applications, to each and all the foregoing applicants and to approve each and all of their bonds, a vote was then taken as follows: Bucklin voted yea, Hards yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Waldroup yea, Carried:

The Mayor reported in favor of extension of the water main from 11th & 12th street on White at the expense of the consumers and on motion his report was accepted and adopted -

The following sidewalks were reported in bad condition In front of Lots 17 & 32 Inc Block 87 and Lots 18 & 34 Inc Block 88 city of Grand Junction also on the South side of Colo. Ave and in front of lots 1 & 2 Block 11 of Mobleys subdivision and in front of lots 1 & 12 inclusive in block 122 city of Grand Junction, whereupon the following resolution was presented:

Whereas in the opinion of a two thirds majority of the City Council it is necessary that a new sidewalk be constructed in front of Lots 17 & 32 inclusive in Block 87 also Lots 18 & 34 inclusive Block 88 also. Lots 1 & 12 inclusive Block 122 all in the City of Grand Junction also in front of Lots 1 & 2 Block 11 of Mobleys Sub. on the South side of Colorado Ave between Spruce and First streets

Therefore let it resolved that a new sidewalk be constructed along and in front of said lots and blocks and that the same be six feet wide instead of 12 feet such as provided by ordinance in such case made and provided:

The Chairman of the water committee reported that the water main was exposed on Colo Ave near the railroad, having been so exposed by the railroad grade, and recommended it be lowered four feet for sufficient distance to insure it against

Annual Levy:

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1904 and ending March 31, 1905, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of the said City both real and personal the following amounts for special and general taxes, namely:

First: For the purpose of paying the annual interest on Water Works bonds, a special tax of 5 Mills upon each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

Second: For the purpose of paying the expenses of running, repairing, and operating the Water Works System a special tax of 5 Mills.

Third: For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of a Free Public Library 1 1/2 Mills on the dollar.

Fourth: For the purpose of defraying the general expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, 13 1/2 Mills on the dollar.

And Be it further Resolved, That the City Clerk be and
