Motion made seconded and put to express a preference for the Lardlaw-Dunn-Gordon proposition No 4 in their specifications, the same being a Cross Compound Meyer Gear, Crank and fly wheel, fork frame outside center packed water end - one H.P. steam cylinder 17" diameter, 1 L.P. steam cylinder 30" diameter - 2 water plungers 10 1/2" diameter all of 24" stroke F. O. B. factory with freight allowed to the City of Grand Junction for \$6385<sup>00</sup> also 1 air pump and jet condenser F. O. B. factory freight allowed to Grand Junction for \$340<sup>00</sup> - Vote was as follows: Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill nay, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton nay, Waldroup yea, carried -
