

Gland Junction Colo Feb 18 1904

Adjourned regular meeting of the City Council Mayor
Sampliner in the Chair, the following aldermen responded to
roll call: Buckins, Hards, Merrill, Rader, Ramey, Smith, and
Stockton, Alderman Waldroup absent:

Minutes of Feb 9th read and approved except to strike out the
word "Streets" from the order requiring the marshal to require
property owners to clean up, so as to read Alleys only -

D & R

On motion the regular order of business was suspended -
And the matter of furnishing water to the D & R RR
with water, was taken up and discussed, There being
present for the RR Co. Mr Knox and Murray:

On motion Mr Geo A Currie was allowed to address
the Council, who protested against the city furnishing
water to the RR Co. The matter was laid over until
next meeting, and Council agreed to give their decision
in the matter by March 1st 1904 -

The expressmen of the city presented a petition asking that
their interest be protected and reported that Co Stacy
was doing express work in the city without a license
The matter was referred to the city attorney with instruction

to report at next meeting:

Furbank, More & Co presented a proposition for a new Hay Scale: It was placed on file

It was reported that the building in the rear of the Star Bakery was in bad condition and should be condemned: referred to Fire & Police Committee:

On motion the parties building the Indian School Sewer were allowed to use the city's old fire hose in settling their ditches - motion made seconded and put that the survey recently made in the N.E part of the city be placed on record in the County Clerk's office - Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Carried =

On motion Matt Maest was given the privilege of connecting with the city water main on east South street and the Superintendent was instructed to have a straightway valve put in at the connection of the two inch pipe on South street:

Motion made seconded and put that the Mayor and Clerk be instructed to sign a lease for one year at \$25.00 per month for the room in the Currie block now occupied by the Mesa Co. Abstract Co. for the use of the Superintendent of Water Works and the City Clerk's office, the same to take effect when the building was vacated by the abstract Co. - Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Carried = A motion prevailed, not to accept the proposition of the Abstract Co. as to the purchase of their furniture:

The matter of changing the course of the irrigation ditch through the property of Mr Hines in Crawford Addition was referred to the Street & Alley Committee =

Motion made seconded and put that Mr James Green be appointed Special Night Policemen without pay:

Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Carried.

It was decided that the council go to the Pump House Tuesday Feb 23 at 2 P.M. to look after the foundation plans and also changes to be made in the building.

The order requiring Mrs Hensel to lay a new sidewalk in front of Lot 17 Block 79 was rescinded and the street Supervisor instructed to require her to repair the old walk.

On motion council adjourned to meet Friday Feb 26th at 8 P.M.
