

Grand Junction Colo Aug 23 1904

Adjourned meeting of the city council President of the Council  
Hards in the Chair, Mayor Sampliner being absent -  
The following aldermen responded to Roll call  
Buckins, Hards, Merrill, Ramey, Rader, Smith, Stockton  
and Waldroup - Reading of the minutes of the previous  
meeting were dispensed with -

City attorney, Carnahan presented his opinion in writing  
as to the legality of an alderman removing from the  
ward from which he was elected to another ward of the City,  
as to whether or not he could legally hold his office -  
This opinion was given at some length and was based on  
the new law, which in the attorney's opinion entitled an  
alderman to retain his office -

Jacques, Holt & Emmer presented a petition asking the  
privilege of erecting a shed in the rear of 425 Main St  
Same to be covered with Corrugated Iron -

Motion made seconded and put to grant them the  
privilege, provided it was all covered with  
Corrugated Iron and no wood exposed -

Motion made seconded and put to furnish the Fruit  
Fair association, <sup>with</sup> water at six (6) cents per thousand  
(1000) gallons and that the water Superintendent be, and  
is hereby instructed to put on a meter, all of which

shall be in force and effect until further order of the City Council; Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Ramey yea, Rader yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup Nay. Carried -

Motion made seconded and put to loan the Grout Fair association 200 feet of hose = Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Ramey Nay, Rader Nay, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup Nay - Carried

Motion made seconded and put that the Water Superintendent is hereby instructed to get bids and let contract to the lowest bidder for the following extensions of the water main  
From Sumner to Keller on North 7<sup>th</sup> Street, 6 inch pipe,  
250 ft on Rood Street west from West Street - 500 ft from 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> Street on Rood - Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Ramey yea, Rader yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup yea, Carried =

Motion made seconded and put that the following Privy, and privy vaults, viz: at 128 Ute avenue, 522 Colorado avenue also No 126 Ute avenue be, and the same are hereby declared to be a nuisance, and dangerous to the health of the inhabitants of the city of Grand Junction and that the owners or agents thereof be notified to abate the same by connecting <sup>within ten days from service thereof</sup> with sewer system of the city or otherwise, or suit will be instituted for maintaining a nuisance, as provided by the Ordinances of said city; Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup yea Carried; On Motion Council adjourned!
