

Grand Junction Colo Sept 29' 1904

Adjourned meeting of the City Council President of the Council
Hards in the Chair, The following Aldermen responded to
roll call, Hards, Merrick, Rader, Ramey and Smith.—
Mayor Sampliner and aldermen Buckins, Stockton and
Waldroup absent— The reading of the minutes and regular
order of business was on motion dispensed with—

The following resolution was introduced by Alderman
Smith who moved its adoption—

Resolution

Annual Levy

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of
Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying
the expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction
for the fiscal year beginning April 1st 1905 and ending
March 31st, 1906, there be and hereby is levied and
assessed upon all the taxable property within the
Corporate limits of the said City of Grand Junction, both
real and personal, the following amounts for special
and general taxes, namely:

First— For the purpose of defraying the annual
interest on Water Works' Bonds a special tax of
5 Mills on each dollar of said property so assessed
or to be assessed.

Second— For the purpose of paying the

expenses of running, repairing and operating, the said Water Works' system a special tax of 3 1/2 mills on each dollar.

Third - For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of a free Public Library 1 Mill on each dollar.

Fourth - For the purpose of defraying the general expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction 13 4/5 Mills on each dollar.

And Be It Further Resolved that the City Clerk be and hereby is directed and instructed to certify this levy to the County Clerk of Mesa County, Colorado, for levy by the Board of County Commissioners of said County, as required by law.

The motion being seconded and put the vote was as follows: Hards voted yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea - Carried -
