

Grand Junction Colo

Oct 18th 1904

Adjourned meeting of the City Council Mayor Sampner in the chair - the following Aldermen responded to roll call Buckins, Hards, Merrill, Rader, Ramey and Stockton, Aldermen Smith and Waldroup absent.

Minutes of regular meeting Oct 11th also of the Special meeting Oct 14 1904 were read and approved.

A petition from Fred Mantey asking the privilege of erecting a one story iron building at the rear of his harness shop at No 342 and 344 Main Street same to be used as a ware room was read and motion made seconded and put to allow him the privilege provided no wood was exposed. Buckins voted yea, Merrill yea, Hards yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea Stockton yea carried.

A Bill of \$38⁷⁵ in favor of BLO Vedder who had

paid the same to Zeb Reese for injuries received at the Princip
 house by being severely burned by Steam, Reese having signed a release
 Motion made seconded and put that the bill be allowed and
 a warrant drawn on the Water fund in payment of same
 Buckins voted yea Hards yea Merrill yea Prader yea Ramey
 yea ~~Smith~~ yea, Stockton yea, Carried

The Bill of W C Boyer for \$500⁰⁰ being the balance
 due on the New City Hall was presented - \$450
 Motion made seconded and put to allow said bill and
 draw a warrant on the Water fund in payment of the same
 Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Ramey yea
 Prader yea, Stockton yea Carried -

Mr Hawkins asked for the extension of water main from
 12th to 13th Street on Road arena -

Motion made seconded and put to extend same 200 feet
 east of 12th St - Buckins voted yea Hards yea Merrill
 yea, Prader yea Ramey yea, Stockton yea Carried -

The George Smith Electric Railway Franchise was
 laid on the table until the next regular meeting
