

Grand Jet Colo Dec 20 1904

Adjourned regular meeting of the City Council Mayor Sampson
in the chair, ^{Aldermen} Bucklin, Hards, Merrill, Rader, Ramey, Smith,
and Waldroup responded to Roll call, Alderman Stockton
absent. Regular Order of Business suspended -

Ord #125
Final Passage
Ordinance No 125 entitled "An Ordinance Granting
to George Smith, his Successors and assigns, the Right to
Construct, Maintain and Operate a System of Street Railway, and
Granting the right of Way Therefor, within the city of Grand
Junction Colorado," was taken upon final Passage
and read at length and considered by the City Council

Sec 1- was adopted as read except to change time limit
on the construction of railway on additional Streets, same to
read, To begin work within two (2) months from the adoption of
the resolution and to have the same completed and in operation
within four (4) months from the adoption of said resolution -

Section 2 was adopted as read -

At this point a motion to lay on the table was made seconded
and put, resulting as follows Bucklin voted yea, Hards Nay,
Merrill Nay, Rader Nay, Ramey yea, Smith Nay, Waldroup yea
Motion lost -

Section Three (3) adopted as read

Section Four (4) amended as to Freight traffic on White avenue,
excluding freight from this street also the City Council of the
City of Grand Jet shall have the right to adopt such rules and
regulations regarding the handling of freight and express from
time to time as they may deem expedient and to prohibit the
handling of the same on certain streets -

Section Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), and Nine (9)
adopted as ^{amended and} read

Section Ten (10) was amended by make first time limit in
which to complete two miles of road in, Eighteen (18) months
and one mile each twelve months thereafter until all
of said streets shall be traversed their entire length, all
rights to be forfeited at the expiration of seven (7) years from the
date of the passage of this ordinance, if the entire length of all said
streets shall not have operated railway thereon -

Section Eleven (11) adopted as read as was also Section
Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16)
Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19) and Twenty (20)
Section Twenty one (21) The Blank per cent was filled

by making it read One and One-half per cent ($1\frac{1}{2}\%$) of the Gross earnings,

Sections Twenty two (22), Twenty three (23) and Twenty four (24) were adopted as read -

Motion made seconded and put that the ordinance No 125 be adopted as amended and read, in its entirety and that the same be published in the Daily Sentinel, The duly authorized legal publication, one issue.

Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Waldroup nay, - Motion Carried - and the ordinance ^{declared passed and adopted} Alderman Merrill was excused on account of illness -

Several Petitions were presented for Arc lights

P A Rice asked for an Arc light at 1st + Rood streets

Paul Kirby petitioned for one at 5th and Belford

D M Wheeler petitioned for one at 1st + Oway streets

J W Harris petitioned for one at 2^d or 3^d on Chipeta.

Alderman Rader acting Chairman of the Light Committee recommended for the best interests of all concerned that the following lights be established, One at 4th and Rood, one at 2^d + Rood one at 3^d + Oway and one at 5th and Belford streets.

Motion made seconded and put to adopt the recommendation and that the Light Committee be instructed to install the same, Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Waldroup yea, Carried -

The Mesa Wine Mercantile Company, by Gail C Murray, presented a petition signed by the property owners in that half block at the ~~NE~~ corner of 4th + Colo Ave, asking that the above named company, be granted a liquor license to conduct a saloon at that point,

Motion made seconded and put that said Company be granted a license on payment of license fee and approval of Bond by the City Council, Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Rader yea, Ramey nay, Smith yea, Waldroup yea - Carried -

Motion made seconded and put, that the Supt. of Water Works be and is hereby instructed to purchase 350 feet of 2 inch pipe and that the same be laid between 2^d and third streets on Gunnison avenue, Buckins voted yea, Hards yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Waldroup yea - Carried -

On motion council adjourned until next regular meeting in January 1905 -
