

Grand Junction Colo April 17 1905

Adjourned Regular meeting of the City Council, Mayor
Sampliner in the chair, The following Aldermen
responded to roll call, Buckins, Hards, Merrie,
Rader, Ramey and Waldroup - Aldermen Smith and
Stockton a few minutes tardy -

Motion made seconded and put that the foregoing bills be allowed and warrants drawn in payment of the same - Buckius voted yea, Harbo yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup yea, - Carried -

A Communication was received from Atty. Carwahan in which he stated that he had prepared an ordinance concerning the Fire Limits which could be brought up at this meeting - and thereupon the following Ordinance was introduced by Alderman Harbo -

"An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 114 entitled

"An Ordinance to amend Section One of Ordinance No. 6, being An Ordinance entitled, An Ordinance Concerning the fire limits, passed and adopted February 10th AD 1903, which was read at length and considered by the City Council - Motion made seconded and put that said Ordinance be passed on its first reading, and be published in the Daily Sentinel one issue - Buckius voted yea, Harbo yea, Merrill yea, Rader yea, Ramey yea, Smith yea, Stockton yea, Waldroup yea, - Carried -

A few well chosen remarks were made by Mayor Sampliner to the Council, thanking them for their courteous treatment etc during the past two years -

A Motion was unanimously carried, thanking the Mayor for the fair and impartial treatment of the Aldermen during the term, after which a motion prevailed to adjourn June. Die These Minutes were approved -
