

So as the time of adjournments of Council on April 21st should
 read "City Council of the City of Grand Junction Colorado convened
 pursuant to adjournment of April 21st 11⁵⁰ am 1905 and adjournment
 of April 21st 4³⁰ pm 1905 and adjournment of April 21st 9⁴⁰ pm 1905"
 there being no further corrections the Mayor declared the
 minutes would stand ^{as} corrected, Alderman Alkire arrived
 during the reading of the minutes and took his seat in
 Council, and by order of the Mayor was recorded Present,
 Alderman Norris entered a motion to take up the
 stipulations of contests, filed by W.H. Bannister Vs J.A. McCulloch
 and Timothy H. Ramey Vs W.H. Bannister and W.C. Stockton Vs
 F.W. Norris and to waive the reading of Contest Petition filed
 by Timothy H. Ramey Vs W.H. Bannister and proceed to hearing
 of contests, seconded by Alderman Platt upon call of Roll
 Vote was as follows, Alderman Alkire yea Davies yea -
 Lutes yea McCulloch yea - Norris yea - Boyle yea -
 Platt yea - Smith yea - there being 8 yeas and no
 nays said motion carried and was so declared by the
 Mayor, Alderman Platt entered a motion that Contest
 Case of W.H. Bannister Vs J.A. McCulloch and Timothy H. Ramey
 Vs W.H. Bannister be heard first, and for the City Clerk to present
 the Ballot Boxes of the Third and First Wards and for Council
 to proceed to canvass the Votes of said Wards, as said
 Contestors and Contestees and their Attorneys S.N. Wheeler and
 S.M. Logan had agreed in their stipulations filed with City
 Clerk and the same having been read before the City
 Council, to waive all preliminary hearings, seconded by
 Alderman Davies, upon motion being called said motion
 carried unanimously, and was so declared by the Mayor,
 Alderman Norris entered a motion to adopt the stipulation
 filed by Timothy H. Ramey as Contestor in Contest Case from Third
 Ward seconded by Alderman Alkire upon motion being called said
 motion carried unanimously, and was so declared by the
 Mayor, Alderman Lutes entered a motion for the
 Mayor to appoint 2 Tellers consisting of two Aldermen
 to canvass Votes and one Alderman to assist City Clerk
 in keeping of tally of Votes canvassed, seconded by Alderman
 Alkire, upon motion being called said motion carried
 unanimously, and was so declared by the Mayor,
 The Mayor thereupon appointed Alderman Boyle and Alkire to
 act as tellers and Alderman Lutes to assist City Clerk.

and then and there the Mayor ordered the election judges from the East West third wards and also the first ward to open the Ballot Boxes and the Tellers to proceed to canvass the Voter, following is a result of the Voter canvassed.
