The City Council of the City of Graud Junction Colo. Convened pursuant to adjournment, of April 26th 12³⁰ am 1905,

Roll Call

Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll, the following Alderman responded present, Alkin - Davies - Lites - McCulloch - Norris - Boyce - Platt - Smith and City Atty N.E. Coles,

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved, -

Purchase of water for city ditches

Alderman Norris entered a motion for Street Supervisor Armstrong to purchase one hundred inches of water for the city to be used in the ditches, seconded by Alderman Platt, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously, and was so declared by the Mayor,

Alderman Smith entered a motion for Clerk to read the applications for appointive offices, seconded by Alderman Atkins, upon motion being called said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

Thereupon the Mayor ruled that Council would pass upon applications as read.

Alderman Norris entered a motion for Mayor to appoint two tellers to distribute blanks to Council for them to vote a closed ballot and for said tellers to collect and read ballots and for Clerk to record ballots for the respective applicants as read by the tellers, seconded by Alderman Atkins, upon motion being called said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.
