The event will mark the completion of the Fire Administration building remodel, the Fire Station #2 (Patterson and 28 1/4 Rd) remodel, the commissioning of all artwork related to the project, and the placing of time capsules and dedication plaques.

Sometime around 11:15 following the ceremonies and prior to the tours of the buildings the old siren used in the early days to call firefighters back to work for big emergency events will be set off to denote the completion of the project. The Siren was last used in the late 70's and was salvaged and put back in working order for this event by Engineer Mark Peterson. The siren after the event will reside in the lobby of the Fire Department Administrative Offices. Please let people know the siren is for this celebration and is not a signal for emergencies.
