The application and bond for a transfer of Beer license from a Schroth to D. Peters & Ellis at 209 Colo ave was referred to the license Committee to report at once, said transfer of license and Bond were approved thereupon ald. Lutes entered a motion that report of License Committee be accepted seconded by ald. Platt upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

ald. Lutes reported that the Contract for roofing the old City Hall had been let.

ald. Platt reported that a new set of City team scales had been purchased and contract for setting let.

ald. Mc Culloch reported that Contract for drinking fountains had been let and taps were being made.

ald. Norris reported that application had been made to the Fire & Police Com. for the erection of a stand on Main Street in front of new Fair Building

the matter was discussed but no final action was taken.

ald. McEulloch entered a ~~motion~~ protest against the fencing in of sidewalk on Main Street in front of new Fair building. this was referred to the City Atty. for advice.

ald. Norris entered a motion that the Bill of § 202.15 presented by the Capitol Hill Lateral Ditch association be allowed and warrant drawn for same and said association to vacate its use of said ditch within fifteen days and abandon all its rights title and interest in and to said ditch, which it may have acquired owing to its work upon said ditch, or which may have been granted to it by any act of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, or from any other cause whatsoever. Seconded by ald. McEulloch, upon call of roll vote was as follows, Alderman Futes yea McEulloch yea Norris yea Boyle yea Platt yea said motion was declared Carried by the Mayor.
