Minutes read

Petition of Wm Grady

Wm Grady petitioned Council to move a barn, now on lot 9 to lot 25 block 120 this was referred to the Fire + Police Com. by the Mayor.

Officers Reports

The following reports of Officers was read, Suph. of Water Works, City Clerk, Treasurers, Police Magistrate and City Scales, they were referred to the Finance Com. by the Mayor.

Petition J.W. Armstrong

J.W. Armstrong reported that there were 45 Street Crossings that required immediate attention. Thereupon ald Norris entered a motion that the Street Commissioner be authorized to put in Crossings where needed, to be either Cement or Board walks, the same to be under the supervision of the Srd. Com. the Crossing at 4th + Col ave to be Cement. Seconded by ald. Smith. upon Call of motion. Said motion Carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

The Com. was instructed to confer with ald. Smith before purchasing the lumber.

ald. Platt reported that the new City Scales were about completed.

ald. Davies reported the actual expense of maintaining the water system monthly, and that in future the same would be done.

Platt entered a motion that Council accept and sustain report of Com. Seconded by Ald. Boyle upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.
