

Grand Junction Colo. Oct. 25<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1905.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened pursuant to adjournment of Oct. 17<sup>th</sup>. Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll, the following responded present, Alderman, Davies, Luter, M<sup>rs</sup>. Bullock, Norris, Boyle, Platt and City Atty. N. E. Coles, the reading of minutes of previous sessions were waived.

The petition of P. P. Langon and others for a sidewalk to be laid along and in front of Lot 12 and east half of Lot 11, Block 56 was referred to the S & A Com. they reported favorable, thereupon Ald. Norris made a motion that report be accepted and affirmed for the laying of said walk, <sup>seconded by Ald. Boyle</sup> upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously. The petition for a 2" water pipe on Pittkin between 7 & 8 was referred to W & S Com.

Purchase Chemicals

The Fair building Co. and A. A. Miller petitioned for a concrete sidewalk to be laid on the East side of 5<sup>th</sup> Street between Main & Colovave, this was referred to the Soc Com. who reported favorable for the laying of a concrete sidewalk, thereupon Ald. McCulloch entered a motion that the report be accepted and Council ratify same seconded by Ald. Boyle upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

Chairman Davies of the W & S. Com. reported favorable upon the petition of J. L. Rankin for the laying of a 2" Water pipe on Bellerave bet. 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>, thereupon Ald. Smith made a motion that the pipe be laid seconded by Ald. Platt upon call of roll vote was as follows, Davies yea Lutes yea, McCulloch yea Norris yea, Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith yea. Motion carried.

Ald. Smith entered a motion for the city atty to draft an ordinance to empower the city Council to be able to condemn any property outside of the fire limits that endangered life and property seconded by Ald. Platt upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

Chairman McCulloch of the Spl Com. reported favorable for the removal of the old Water Works stand pipe on 7<sup>th</sup> Street, thereupon Ald. Boyle entered a motion that the report be sustained and Council ratify same seconded by Ald. Norris upon call of roll vote was as follows, Davies yea Lutes yea, McCulloch yea, Norris yea, Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith yea, motion carried.

Chairman Norris of the Fire & Police Com. reported that the supply of Fire Chemicals was short and advised the purchase of more chemicals, thereupon Ald. Davies made a motion that the Fire & Police Com. purchase the Chemicals seconded by Ald. Platt upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

The matter of securing some permanent dumping ground for garbage was discussed. Ald. Platt took up the matter of using the street grader during the fall months and it was agreed that same would be done. Thereupon Ald. Boyle made a motion to adjourn until next regular meeting Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> seconded by Ald. Davies upon call of motion said motion carried and was so declared by the Mayor.
