There was considerable discussion in regard to the removal of the old water works stand pipe but no final action was taken.

Chairman Norris of the Fire & Police Com. made a partial report for securing a permanent dumping ground for city garbage he was instructed to make a final report next regular meeting with recommendations.

The following Resolution was introduced by Ald. Norris seconded by Ald. Davies, It is the sense of this Council that the purchasers of these due bills of indebtedness be allowed the same percentage as a warrant issued in due form of law would do at their time of redemption, upon call of roll Vote was as follows Ald. Davies yea, Futer yea, M. C. Culloch yea, Norris yea, Boyle yea Platt yea, Motion carried.

Plumber License

The License Com. reported favorable upon the application for plumber license of Lewis & Sallee and unfavorable upon the application of Furber & Coulter thereupon Ald. Futer made a motion seconded by Ald. Platt that the report of Com. be accepted and sustained, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

In Regard to laying gutter on Main between 3rd & 5th Street

Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Davies that the S. A. Com. call upon the property owners on the South side of Main St. between 3rd & 5th and secure the Consent of 2/3 of them in regard to laying a Cement gutter and then proceed to do so without further orders, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

Janitors salary increased

Ald. Davies entered a motion seconded by Ald. Futer to increase the salary of City Hall Janitor to \$12.50 Per month upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Transfer of \$250.00 to Gen Fund

Ald. Platt entered a motion seconded by Ald. Norris that the sum of \$250.00 realized from the sale of old water pump should be placed to the credit of the General Fund, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Hire teams to run street grader

Ald. M. C. Culloch made a motion seconded by Ald. Platt that the S. A. Com. be empowered to hire a man to run the street grader for ten days he to furnish the teams and men and not to interfere with City teams, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
