Roll Call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened at regular monthly meeting. Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present alderman Alkire, Davies, Norris, Boyle, Platt, W.M. Smith, and City Clerk N.E. Coles. Alderman Lutero arrived a few minutes late, The minutes of Dec. 13th 1905 were read and approved,

The petition of Groves & Smith for a permit to erect an extension on the rear of the Alderman building at 440 Main St. was referred to the Fire and Police Com.

Barthey & Dumbek

Barthey and Dumbek petitioned for a plumbers license and it was referred to the license Com.

Petition for
Racks & Posts.

The Chamber of Commerce petitioned Council to erect racks and hitching posts at some suitable place for the convenience of the ranchers, also that a City market be located and established, it was referred to the Sra Com.

Reports of Officers read were as follows City Clerk Water Supt, Police Magistrate, City Asses, Fire Chief, City Treasurer, and Chairman water Com.

Chairman Platt of the Sra Com. reported favorable for a sidewalk to be ordered laid on Curay St. from lot 16 Blk 56 to 2nd St. and requested further time in regard to the opening of

Chulouton air in Cranford add. and the Committee decided not to take any action for the removal of the lunch tables on the street corners. Thereupon Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Norris that the report of Com. be accepted and sustained, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously and was so declared by the Mayor.

Com Reports

Chairman Norris of the Fire Police Com. requested that further time be granted them to report upon the request of Fire Chief Rogers to advance the pay of Volunteer firemen. they were granted further time by the Mayor.

Ald. Lutes entered a motion seconded by Ald. Platt to reconsider the action taken by Council Dec. 13th 1905 in regard to the petition of C.P.M. Cary ^{to} place a Corrugated iron roof on his Black Smith Shop upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Ald. Norris of a spl. Com. recommended the purchase of 10 acres of land lying west of Cemetery from A.L. Gourley at \$35⁰⁰ per acre to be used as a dumping ground for the city there was no action taken and the Com. was continued.

The City Clerk was instructed to find out time of occupancy of County Surveyor at the city Fire hall and collect rental for same at the rate of \$10⁰⁰ per month. the motion was made by Ald. Davies seconded by Ald. Lutes upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
