

Grand Junction Colo. Feb. 14th A.D. 1906.

Roll Call
The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened at a regular meeting, Mayor Bunting presiding, the upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Davis, Lutes, Norris, Boyle, Platte, Smith, & City atty N. E. Coles. Ald. McCulloch arrived a few minutes late, Ald. Alkire absent.

Minutes
The minutes of previous meeting Jan 24th 1906 were read and approved.

Janitor
E. C. Robb
The application of E. C. Robb for the position of Janitor of the City Hall was read, thereupon Ald. Platt entered a motion, seconded by Ald. Norris that E. C. Robb be appointed Janitor upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

- Post Office Inspector Frederick
A Communication from A. P. Frederick, Post Office Inspector, relative to the Crawford and Mobley additions, for a City Free Delivery Service he advised that the houses would have to be numbered Sidewalks laid and nine additional Arc Lights erected, before the Government would authorize the extension of City Free Delivery Service to the aforesaid additions, Thereupon Alderman Davis, made a motion seconded by Ald Platt, that the communication be laid upon the table and to notify Mr. A. P. Frederick that the City would comply to the demands required by the Government as soon as practicable, upon call of motion said motion Carried unanimously.
- H. F. Hiatt pet to build.
The petition of H. F. Hiatt to build an extension on his Blacksmith Shop was referred to the Fire & Police Com.
- Belford Grade to be cut
The petition of J. J. Jackson and others to have Belford ave cut to established grade between 6th & 7th streets was referred to the S & A Com.
- W. C. Boyer Pet. to build Bowling alley
The petition of W. C. Boyer to erect a Bowling alley Building was read, Thereupon Ald. McCulloch made a motion seconded by Ald. Lutes that the Fire & Police Com. in conjunction with the Fire Chief be empowered to authorize any alterations in the Bowling alley or Auditorium that would be detrimental to the public safety. upon call of motion said motion Carried unanimously.
- A. N. Anderson Pet. to rebuild on Colo Ave
The Petition of A. N. Anderson to repair the building on lot 22 Block 119 was read, Ald. Platt made a motion seconded by Ald. Lutes that said petition be referred to the Fire & Police Com., and if in their judgement the building can be repaired and not conflict with the Ordinance, to allow them to proceed, upon call of motion said motion Carried unanimously.
- D. B. Brooks pet for sidewalk to be laid
The Petition of D. B. Brooks and others for a sidewalk to be ordered laid from Herman St. to end of Road St. running west on North side, then on West ave from Road to Main on East side was referred to S & A Com.
- Keiths add. pet. for Sewer District.
The Petition of H. R. Rhone and others to have the part of Keiths addition lying north of the railroad organized into a sewer district under the law and a sewer system constructed, was referred to the Water & Sewer Com.
- Library Light placed
Dr. Bradbury was present and announced that he was delegated by the Board of Trustees of the Carnegie Library to petition the City Council for an Arc light to be placed in front of the Library building and that they also requested that the money for the lighting of the Library building be taken from some other fund, Thereupon Ald. Norris entered

a motion seconded by Ald Luter that an Arc light be placed at the intersection of the street, and the electric light bills be paid from the Light fund after April 1st 1906. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Report Officers Police Magistrate, City Treasurer, City Sealer, Water Superintendent & City Clerk. they were referred to the Finance Com.

Chairman Davies of the Water Com. read his monthly report,

upon the recommendation of the Fire Chief
Disinfectants ald Smith made a motion seconded by ald, W. Culloch that the City purchase 30 Gals of Anti German disinfectant. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
