The petition of E. E. Jencks and others living in Carpenters Sub. was read, they prayed for a 2" water pipe to be laid instead of the 3/4" now in use, said petition was referred to the Water + Sewers Committee.

The Minn. Timber Supply Co. by F. E. Gowan manager petitioned, to cross lower 7<sup>th</sup> street with a R.R. spur on north side of track running to Sugar Factory, said petition was referred to the street and alley Committee.

Sidewalk Kardund

Upon report of Alderman Norris that there was no sidewalk in front of Lots 7 + 8 Block one Crawford addition, Street Commissioner Armstrong was instructed to notify the property owner Gus Gustason who resides at Silverton Colo. to build said sidewalk within fifteen days.

- A petition signed by J. Ernest Leaverton in behalf of the inhabitants living in Crawford add, <sup>was read</sup> They requested that the crossing between Fairview ave and 4th ave be opened up both road and sidewalk, that a street be opened up through Mobley add, north and south from Fairview ave, to Colorado ave, and that sidewalk be put in over the railroad crossing on Colorado ave. said petition was referred to the street & alley Committee to report at next meeting of Council.

R. J. Bolles to  
extend water  
main on Hood  
bet 12<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup>
- A. B. Hutchinson was present, and made a verbal request in behalf of R. J. Bolles, for the city to extend the water mains on Hood ave, from 12<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> streets, Mr. Bolles to do the same at his own expense to be reimbursed without interest by the city at such a time that the revenue received <sup>would pay 6%</sup> from same would permit. said request was referred to the Committee on water & sewers.
- Sidewalk ordered  
laid from  
Herman to Hood
- Chairman Platt of the street and alley Committee reported favorable upon laying a sidewalk from Herman to Hood street and unfavorable upon laying a sidewalk from on West ave from Hood to main street. thereupon Alderman Alkire made a motion seconded by Alderman Boyle that said report be accepted and Council ratify same upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
- Belford ave bet  
6 & 7 to be cut  
to established  
grade
- Chairman Platt of the street and alley Committee reported favorable upon the petition of property owners residing on Belford ave between 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> street to have said street cut to established grade, thereupon Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman Alkire that said report be accepted and Council ratify same upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

- Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt that Council go into executive session, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Alkire to return to regular order of business upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

- Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt to adjourn until April 4<sup>th</sup> A. D. 1906 upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
